Eligibility for Pupil Premium Funding

Pupil Premium funding is an allocated amount of money paid directly to schools. The funding supports the teaching, learning and well-being of pupils who are eligible. Pupils who can access this funding can either be:

- Eligible for Free School Meals or
- A 'Looked after child' in the care of the Local Authority
- Children adopted from care on or after 30th December 2005
- Children who left care under a Special Guardianship Order (SGO) on or after 30th December 2005 and
- Children who left care under a Residence Order (RO) on or after 14th October 1991.

If any family has a child who meets the above criteria please do inform myself or the school office in order for school to claim the funding that will aid their wellbeing and education. We do fully appreciate that this information is confidential and therefore completely voluntary.
